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Introduction

The animations can be used like you would a video / an e-book / a story book.
Feel free to:

- play them for children to simply listen to and enjoy as you would a story or do more with it like any story: stop it, encourage learners to participate, ask questions, get learners to mime, etc.
- use the images and simply point to them and say the words without necessarily playing the sound, to start with.

Présentation

This animation presents 8 space-related words:

- un astronaute (astronaut)
- une planète (planet)
- un martien (martian)
- un robot (robot)
- une fusée (space rocket)
- une comète (comet)
- un satellite (satellite)
- une étoile (star)

You could listen to the animation with your pupils a first time and then go over each illustration, pausing the animation if necessary, to practise the vocabulary. With younger learners it might be worth checking they know what the image is in English first before teaching the French. The first 4 words sound like the English and are things that young children should know:

- un astronaute (astronaut)
- une planète (planet)
- un martien (martian)
- un robot (robot)
